Profile

Nueva Vizcaya State University (NVSU) was established in 2004

through Republic Act No. 9272, merging the Nueva Vizcaya State

technic College (NVSPC). This unification, led by the late Congressman and Governor Carlos M. Padilla, transformed NVSU into a premier institution of higher learning, serving over 15,000 students across its Bayombong and Bambang campuses.

Under the leadership of President Dr. Wilfredo A. Dumale, Jr., NVSU offers 44 undergraduate and 26 graduate programs, spanning disciplines such as Agriculture, Forestry, Business Education, Industrial Technology, and Veterinary Medicine. With a dedicated workforce of more than 900 faculty and staff, NVSU fulfills its four-fold mandate: Instruction, Research and Development, Extension, and Production.

NVSU's excellence is recognized globally. In 2024, it ranked 154th out of 12,000 institutions in the World University Rankings for Innovation (WURI), excelling in Culture/Values (26th), Leadership (43rd), and Social Responsibility (44th). It is also one of only 19 state universities in the Philippines to achieve SUC Level IV accreditation and holds ISO 9001:2015 certification for its quality management system.

A leader in research, NVSU houses the Citrus Research and Resources Development Center, making it the country's top institution for citrus research. Its commitment to cultural preservation is reflected in its engagement with 18 indigenous peoples' groups in the province. NVSU is also a key player in international academic collaboration as a member of the University Mobility in Asia and the Pacific (UMAP), promoting student and faculty exchanges.

The university's accolades include the CHED Center of Excellence for Forestry and the CHED Center of Development for Agriculture. NVSU also received the Bronze Level award in 2021 from the Civil Service Commission's PRIME-HRM program, highlighting its strong human resource management.

NVSU continues to thrive as a center of academic and research excellence, producing thousands of graduates annually and contributing to the region's educational and cultural landscape.

NVSU *Timeline*

NVSU was formed by merging the two largest state-run colleges in Nueva Vizcaya: Nueva Vizcaya State Institute of Technology (NVSIT) in Bayombong, with a 148.5-hectare campus, and Nueva Vizcaya State Polytechnic College (NVSPC) in Bambang, with a 14.21-hectare campus. The merger was solidified by Republic Act 9272, granting university status on March 20, 2004.

- 1916** ● NVSIT began as a farm settlement school in Bayombong
- 1946** ● Southern Nueva Vizcaya Junior High School (SNVJHS) was established in Bambang, later becoming Bambang High School (BHS)
- 1956** ● Nueva Vizcaya Rural High School (NVRHS) was upgraded to Nueva Vizcaya National Agricultural School (NVNAS)
- 1957** ● Bambang High School (BHS) was converted to Nueva Vizcaya School of Arts and Trades (NVSAT).
- 1964** ● Nueva Vizcaya National Agricultural School (NVNAS) became Nueva Vizcaya Agricultural College (NVAC)
- 1973** ● Nueva Vizcaya Agricultural College (NVAC) was transformed into Nueva Vizcaya State Institute of Technology (NVSIT)
- 1983** ● Nueva Vizcaya School of Arts and Trades (NVSAT) was upgraded to Nueva Vizcaya State Polytechnic College (NVSPC)
- 2001** ● A study was initiated to merge Nueva Vizcaya State Institute of Technology (NVSIT) and Nueva Vizcaya State Polytechnic College (NVSPC)
- 2004** ● Nueva Vizcaya State University (NVSU) was officially established on March 20 through Republic Act 9272
- 2005** ● Dr. Marilou Gilo-Abon became the first president of Nueva Vizcaya State University (NVSU)

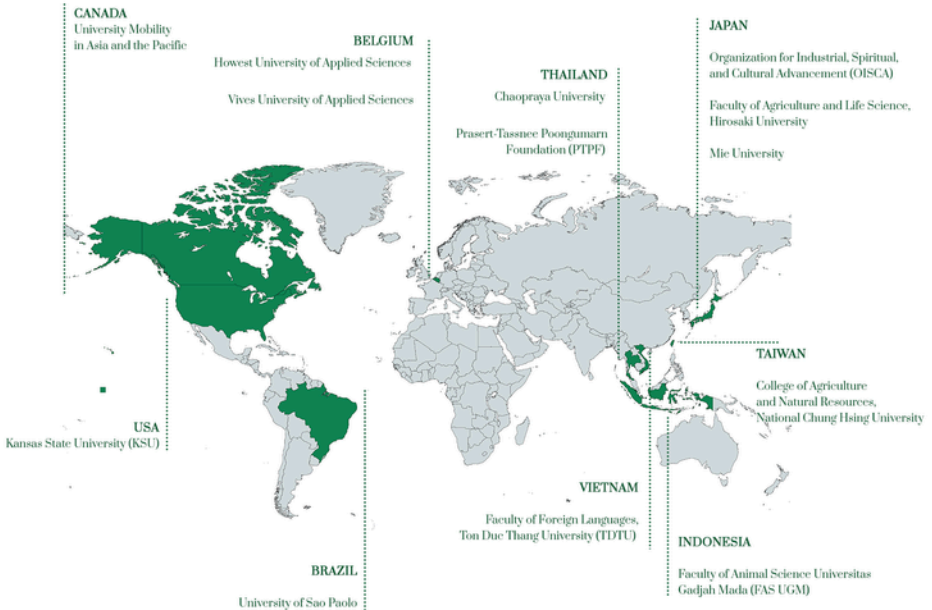
